Demand of aluminum beverage can in 2012

The Aluminum Can Recycling Association (Chairman, Mr. Takao Fujiwara, President of Showa Aluminum Can, Limited) recently revealed the estimated demand of aluminum beverage can in calendar year 2011 and 2012.

According to the announcement, the demand in 2011 increased 1.3 per cent from the previous year to 18.8 billion can, in which the demand for beer decreased 2.7 per cent and the various drinks except beer increased 5.1 per cent year on year.

The beer breweries have gloomy prospects: the beer consumption marked the highest in 2007 and then the consumption becomes lower gradually year by year causing the aging society and the decrease of drinkers.

Therefore the association estimates that the total demand in 2012 will be 18.8 billion can similar to the previous year, but the beer can is estimated 2.8 per cent of decrease. And the verious drinks can execut beer and imported beer is estimated increase.

JARA estimates 1.7% growth in fiscal 2012

The Japan Aluminum Refiners Association recently revealed the secondary aluminum alloy demand in fiscal 2012 starts in April 2012 and ends in March 2013.

According to the announcement, the demand in fiscal 2012 increases 1.7 per cent from the previous year to 1,508,100ton. Regarding the prediction in fiscal 2012, the association has a careful outlook the auto production is favorable right now, but the Europe's sovereign debt crisis is still a great, unsolved and gloomy problem for world economy.

The table on page three shows the prediction of secondary aluminum alloy demand in fiscal 2012, in which 22 means fiscal 2010, 23 means fiscal 2011 and 24 means fiscal 2012

Top line shows cast, second die cast, third sheet and extrusion, fourth steel and others and bottom total. The right side figures are the comparison with the previous year. The figures include the consumption of imported ingot. Unit is ton.
