Comparison of year end metals prices 2013-2014

Remarkable rise of aluminum

The aluminum price rose strikingly at metals market this year. Traditionally, the aluminum market has been firm, but this year's aluminum market amazed us very much. Comparing with other metals' market prices movements, it was unusual after discounting of devalued yen.

We think that the reason would be an integrated imbalance between the reasonable increase of consumption and the negative production under unprofitable conditions. The recent growth of aluminum demand seems to be slowing down internationally, and we'd better have a lookout for the reaction of aluminum market.

Outlook in 2005

In every country and area, the economic growth is moderate or slowing down. Consequently, it isn't thought that the demand of every commodity will increase favorably in 2015.

In Japan, the devalued yen will push up the prices of all imported materials distinctly, which will push the consumption mind down justly. During past two years, the yen devalued really 46 per cent, which will be a great economic and social difficulty of Japan in coming year.
