The secondary aluminum alloy production in first half of 2016 increases 1.5%

The Japan Aluminum Alloy Refiners Association recently revealed the production and the shipment of secondary aluminum alloy in the first half of 2016. According to the announcement, the production increased 1.5 per cent to 388,675 ton, and the shipment also increased 0.8 per cent to 391,843 ton.

The increase of production volume was for the first time in four years, and the increase of shipment volume was for the first time in three years.

Classifying the sector of demand, the main demand, diecast, swelled 4.8 per cent to 223,830 ton, which was supported by the brisk export of knock-down parts for automobile and the increased production of Toyota's Plius.

Contrarily, the biggest decrease was sheet, which dropped 7.4 per cent to 26,742 ton. It was affected severely by the bearish market of primary aluminum at London Metal Exchange.

The chart on page three shows the production, shipment and comparison with the previous same period of secondary aluminum alloy in the first half of 2016. From top, total production, total shipment, cast, diecast, sheet, extrusion, steel and alloy.

The Japan of today Government debt hits new record

Japan's central government debt swelled to a record high \(\pm\)1,053.4 trillion as of the end of June 2016, the Ministry of Finance preliminarily reported on August 10. The amount, which includes government bonds, borrowings and financial bills, totals \(\pm\)8.29 million in debt for every man, woman and child in Japan.

The total government bonds outstanding exceeded \(\pm\)1,000 trillion in the end of June 2013, and then, the expansion is just as it was.

Today, the Government still projects to continue economic stimulative measures with red ink bond,
