Comparison of year end metals prices 2015-2016

Staple prices of major metals

There was no obvious change at the market prices of major practical metals, steel, aluminum and copper, between in the end of 2015 and 2016 on a yen basis. The prices showed an increase of ten per cent in US dollar, but the yen went up ten percent against US dollar. Accordingly, the prices in yen were almost unchanged after all.

The movement of metals' market has been affected by the energy prices' change, however today, Chinese over production capacity and its operation rates with the government policy are big factors on the market changes.

Outlook in 2017

Trump new president's the U.S. government is going to start in New Year. During the president election, he insisted a protective trade policy clearly and powerfully. Consequently, the new government will part from the traditional principal of free trade.

When the import of industrial products are reduced, or raised by the higher import tax, U.S. citizens' life will be strained necessarily. At the same time, the most export countries will be shrunk by smaller buyer.

New international circumstances

The recent prominent power to toward conservation in the U.K. and in the U.S. brings a chaotic state to world politics and economy. TPP

TPP is short for Trans Pacific Strategic Economic Partnership, which made an agreement with southern Pacific four countries, New Zealand, Chili, Singapore and Burunei, about the abolishment of tariff and the liberalization money and labor in 2006 at first.

Then Peru, Vietnam, Australia, Malaysia, the U.S. and Japan participated, and the final agreement was going to be concluded in the near future. However, coming president Mr. Trump declared the nonparticipation of the U.S. distinctly, which gives a great shock against other nine countries today.

Japan and TPP

After the U.S. worked out of TPP, the participating countries are almost agricultural states, whose the biggest expectation to Japan would be the open-door policy of agricultural products and livestock products.
