JARA estimates 1.4 per cent growth in fiscal 2017

The Japan Aluminum Alloy Refiners Association held a board of directors on March 24 in Osaka, where the presumption of secondary aluminum alloy demand in fiscal 2016, started in April 2016 and ended in March 2017, and its prediction in fiscal 2017, starts in April 2017 and ends in March 2018, were approved and revealed subsequently.

According to the announcement, the overseas economic activity was weak in the first half of 2016, but the Japanese economy showed a slow recovery. The personal consumption and private investment were weak, but the income circumstances showed some improvement supported by the government. Totally, a slow recovery performed in fiscal 2016 domestically,

Overcoming the big damage by Kumamoto earthquake, the major demand, diecast and cast for automobile, increased. Ultimately, the total demand in fiscal 2016 increased 2.6 per cent year on year to 1,634,100 ton.

Regarding the demand in fiscal 2017, the association predicts that it increases 1.4 per cent from the previous fiscal year to 1,657,300 ton, and the association comments as follows.

- (1) The major demand for diecast and cast will increase gradually. The market and production of automobile will be steady, and the export of knock-down parts will be pretty active.
- (2) The surged demand for coffee can will be calm down, and the demand for sheet will be as same level as the previous fiscal year.
- (3) The demand for steel will increase slowly.

The table on page one shows the prediction of secondary aluminum alloy demand,

on which 27 means fiscal 2015, 28 means fiscal 2016 and 29 means fiscal 2017. Top line shows cast, second diecast, third sheet and extrusion, fourth steel and others and bottom total. The right side figures show the comparison with the previous years.

The tonnage includes the consumption of imported ingot. Unit is ton.

International news <u>Aluminum stock decreases in LME increases in SHFE</u>

On March 20, the London Metal Exchange warehouse stock of aluminum marked 1,985,875 ton, the lowest since the highest record 5,500,000 ton level in January 2014.

Reversely in China, the Shanghai Future Exchange's stock increased to 316.333 ton, the highest level, on March 17 since 2016 April. The stock bottomed in December 2016, and then the stock is increasing.

This opposing movements of aluminum warehouses stock are very interesting.

<u>Aluminum production down in China, up in others</u>

On March 20, The International Aluminum Institute revealed the production of aluminum in February. China is the biggest producer in the world, and its daily output was 95,000 ton, which decreased from 95,200 ton in the previous month. The monthly production was 2,534,000 ton, and the previous monthly production was 2,950,000 ton, which level is the lowest production since last April.

In other area, the daily output was 75,000 ton, increased from 70,000 ton in the previous month. The monthly production was 1,973,000 ton, decreased from 2,170,000 ton of the previous month.

Anti-Korean nationalism in China

Against North Korean military threat, the Korean government decided the installation of the U.S. missile interceptor system. Opposing this Korean movement, the Chinese government began trying to annoy Korea through national media, such as the trade boycott to Korea, or the interruption to Korean sightseeing tour.

It was reported that the Lotte, one of Korean zaibatsu, offered one part of their land for the installation of the system, and as the result, 87 supermarkets were forced to close within 99 stores of Lotte in China.

The plunder at Japanese supermarkets or the violence against Japanese cars were the incidents some years ago. China has to recall that the past unpleasant relation between Japan and China is not over.
